## **Code of Conduct**

### **For all Parents and Visitors to the Club**

- Parents/spectators/visitors are not permitted into the gym training area unless invited by the Instructor. It is usual practice that a parent may be present during their child's first lesson. However, the parent must understand that it is the Instructor that is in charge of the class and refrain from disrupting it in any way.
- To conform to the children's act (child protection law) it is an offence to Film/Video and photograph any child/young adult under 18 years of age. Anyone found doing so will be reported to the police and expelled from the club.
- Respect the Instructors, volunteers, officials and administrators, and encourage children to do likewise. Without them your child would not be able to participate.
- Parents must note that the Club is not responsible for the martial artist until the commencement of the class. It is the parents' responsibility to deliver their child into the care of the Instructor and to ensure that the class is to be run as normal
- It is the parents' responsibility to regularly check the Club online notice board, as important information will be displayed there
- It is the parents' responsibility to ensure all memberships, insurances and training fees are paid when due.
- It is the parents' responsibility to inform the Club using the appropriate form of intention to cancel monthly fee payments for classes one month in advance using the cancellation form available online.
- Parents must ensure that the Club is kept informed of any medical conditions, illness, injuries and ongoing treatments. If the Club is not informed of such, the parents are then declaring their child fully fit to take part in martial arts activities
- In cases of absence, a message should be left with the club, prior to the start of the training session
- The club cannot be responsible for children outside of their class times and children should not be left unattended in the building. A record will be made of children not collected on time following their class and a charge made of

£5.00 for every ½ hour accumulated. If a child is regularly left unattended, Social Services will be informed

**For further guidance please remember**

- Children participate in this sport for their benefit, not yours
- Encourage children to participate, do not force them
- Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing
- Encourage. Don't criticise
- Criticism of other students / coaches can be upsetting to all and is frowned upon by the Club
